I understand that if I receive a scholarship that fact will become part of a permanent public record.

I agree to abide by the following GUSTO Scholarship Payment Guidelines.

To receive award payments as announced a student must be enrolled in a post secondary program and be in attendance for the fall semester and be considered a full time student. (Student must send proof of enrollment, including number of units, to Gusto.) Failure to do so may result in a loss of the awarded scholarship. All scholarship award money will be paid directly to the school of attendance (with exceptions as noted below). For scholarships of \$500 or more, the payments may be made in two equal increments at the beginning of the first and second semesters. Students who are granted a scholarship for a four-year school and instead enroll in a two-year or vocational program will have the award reduced as noted below. When a student who has been chosen to receive an award changes educational plans the Board reserves the right to cancel or alter the award.

4. STUDENTS WITH NON-ENROLLMENT

If students do not enroll the first semester, they may have their award extended to the next semester of that year if approved by the GUSTO Board.

If a student's situation requires an extension, a student must submit an explanation letter and request an extension prior to the beginning of the semester. The requests must be voted on and approved by the GUSTO Board.

2. PART-TIME STUDENTS

Students who are unable to maintain a full-time status may request an extension of their award for one semester by submitting a written request to the GUSTO Board. The student will be required to maintain the approved level of GPA to qualify for the extension.

3. EXCESS FUNDS

Payment should be made directly to the college. The college would be requested to first pay the student's housing and tuition expenses. If scholarship funds are not needed during the current semester, the money can be applied to the next semester. If there is an excess of funds in the student's account, the college may reimburse the student directly, with proper documentation and/or receipts as determined by the GUSTO Board.

4. A FOUR-YEAR SCHOOL RECIPIENT WHO TRANSFERS TO A TWO-YEAR OR VOCATIONAL SCHOOL

Student may qualify for the maximum allocated amount for a two-year or vocational school as determined by the GUSTO Board.

This form must be turned in with your GUSTO application with all the following at one time:

Failure to include ALL four of the above elements in your scholarship packet will result in the disqualification of your application.
